1. Each Institution may send up to two participants of 8th to 12th Classes only.
2. Both the participants should not be from the same class.
3. Sheet for the competition would be provided by the Department but the colours and other stuff has to be brought by the respective student from their own resources.
4. The last date for the receipt of the confirmation of participation in writing duly attested by the Principal is 26th September, 2016 upto 4:30 p.m. and after that no request would be entertained, as it will help the organizers to arrange the requirements.
5. The participating students are requested to carry their School I-Cards for identification on 28th September, 2016.
6. The programme will start at 10:00 a.m. sharp on 28th September, 2016.
7. The topic would be announced on the spot only.
8. It is left to the choice of a participant to use any of the following media: oil-paint, water-colour, pencil or ink. Use of poster and pastel colours is also allowed.
9. The results would be declared only on 2nd October, 2016 during the special lecture.
10. The decision of the judges would be final and binding.
11. Each student would be awarded participation certificate
12. The 1st, 2nd, 3rd and one Consolation prizes would be awarded with certificate and cash prizes of the amount Rs. 1000/-, 700/-, 500/- and 300/- respectively by the Chief Guest on 2nd October, 2016 in Gandhi Bhawan, Panjab University, Chandigarh.
