To celebrate this occasion, we would be conducting one week long programmes and in this series on 29th September, 2022 we are organizing on the spot Painting Competition of School Children from 10: 30 a.m. onwards. In this respect, your Prestigious School is cordially invited to participate in the events, so that we can make it a successful event and can spread Gandhiji's message of **Universal Brotherhood**.

Rules for on the Spot Painting Competition:

1. Each Institution may nominate two participants of the age group of 10 to 17 years old only.
2. Sheet for the competition would be provided by the Department but the colours and other stuff has to be brought by the respective student from their own resources.
3. The last date for the receipt of the confirmation of participation in writing duly attested by the Principal is 28th September, 2022 upto 4:30 p.m. and after that no request would be entertained, as it will help the organizers to arrange the requirements.
4. The participating students are requested to carry their School I-Cards for identification on 29th September, 2022.
5. The programme will start at 10:30 a.m. sharp on 29th September, 2022 and the time limit for the same will be only 02 Hours.
6. The topic would be announced on the spot only.
7. The theme/painting should not be in any form of vulgar or disrespecting the authority of anyone.
8. It is left to the choice of a participant to use any of the following media: oil-paint, water-colour, pencil or ink or poster and pastel colours.
9. The results would be declared only on 2nd October, 2022 during the special lecture.
10. The decision of the judges would be final and binding.
11. Each student would be awarded participation certificate
12. The 1st, 2nd, 3rd and one Consolation prize would be awarded with certificate and cash prizes of the amount Rs. 1000/-, 700/-, 500/- and 300/- respectively by the Chief Guest on 2nd October, 2022 in Gandhi Bhawan, Panjab University, Chandigarh.
